ST LAWRENCE SCHOOL OF FOOTBALL CODE OF CONDUCT

COACHES, TEAM MANAGERS AND CLUB OFFICIALS

Must:

- Show respect to officials, opposition players, coaches, managers, officials and spectators
- Adhere to the Laws of the Game
- Display and promote high standards of behaviour
- Always respect the match officials' decisions
- Never enter the field of play without the referee's permission
- Never engage in public criticism of the match officials
- Never engage in, or tolerate, offensive, insulting or abusive language or behaviour.

When working with players, I must:

- Place the well-being, safety and enjoyment of each player above everything, including winning
- Explain exactly what I expect of players and what they can expect from me
- Ensure the parents/carers of all players under the age of 18 understand these expectations
- Refrain from, and refuse to tolerate any form of bullying
- Develop mutual trust and respect with every player to build their self-esteem
- Encourage each player to accept responsibility for their own behaviour and performance
- Ensure all activities I organise are appropriate for the players' ability level, experience, age and maturity

o-operate fully with officials, doctors, physiotherapists, welfare officers for each player's best interests

Spectators and Parents

Must:

- Remain outside the field of play and behind the Designated Spectator Area (where provided)
- Never engage in, or tolerate, offensive, insulting or abusive language or behaviour
- Always respect the match officials' decisions
- Applaud effort and good play as well as success

In addition, when attending youth games, I must:

- Remember that children play for FUN
- Let the coaches do their jobs and not confuse the players by telling them what to do
- Encourage the players to respect the match officials and the opposition
